## Daily Summary for March 7, 2022



With a vote of 95-1 and 1 member voting present, the House advanced [HB1117](#), the bill to amend the [Revenue Stabilization Law](#).

This bill outlines the \$6 billion budget for the 2023 Fiscal Year.

The budget is less than a 3% increase in spending from the current fiscal year.

The proposed budget includes a \$70 million increase for elementary and secondary education.

County jail reimbursement is increased by \$6.4 million.

It also calls for a \$7.4 million increase for Arkansas State Police. This will assist in raising the salaries for state troopers.

The budget provides \$37.6 million to help alleviate the waiting list for services for Arkansans with developmental disabilities.

The budget also includes the transfer of \$150 million for various one-time funding projects including prison construction.

The House will reconvene Tuesday at 9 am.
