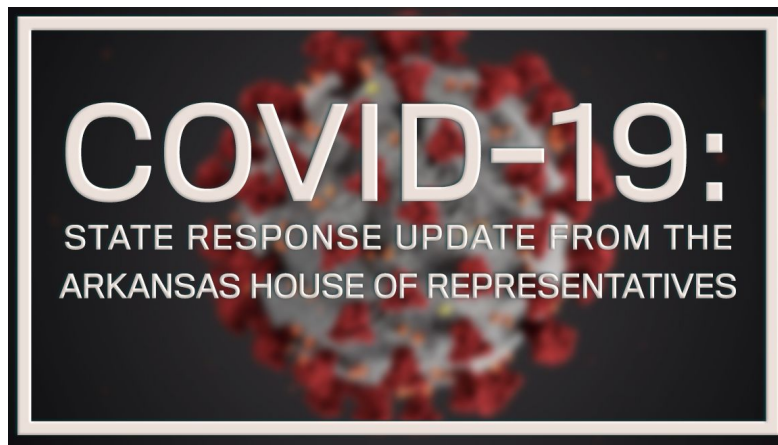

Covid-19 Response Update for March 30, 2020



- Of the 473 cases of COVID-19 in Arkansas, 73 are health care workers.
- There are 62 people currently hospitalized and 21 on ventilators.
- There are now 5 nursing homes in the state with confirmed COVID-19 cases.
- House and Senate leadership voted to approve \$45 million from the recently created COVID-19 Rainy Day Fund for additional purchases of personal protective equipment (PPE) and ventilators.
- The Governor announced that Arkansas will be receiving \$1.25 billion in federal funds between now and December 30 for COVID-19 related costs. The Governor has appointed a 15 member steering committee to guide recommendations for spending.
- Arkansas State Parks continue to remain open but remind guests to practice social distancing. The agency has closed lodges, visitor centers, museums and is limiting camping to RVs.
