Covid-19 Response Update for May 1, 2020



The Governor announced today that barber, cosmetology, massage therapy, body art, and medical spa services will be allowed to resume on May 6.

The new directives for these services include:

- Ten or fewer people in the facility
- Larger facilities, no more than 30% of stations in operation
- No walk-in appointments
- Clients should wait outside or in cars until ready
- Time set between appointments for cleaning
- 6-foot distance between clients during appointments, in the waiting area
- Client names, contact information recorded
- Vulnerable populations should consider staying home
- Face coverings required for staff. Clients must also wear as services permit
- Gloves should be worn

- Hands must be washed before and after services
- Screening of staff and clients
- Postpone services if any symptoms
- Thorough cleaning and disinfection
- Schools not included

The Department of Health is creating a Dental Advisory Board to assist in guiding dentists as they resume some practices on May 18.
