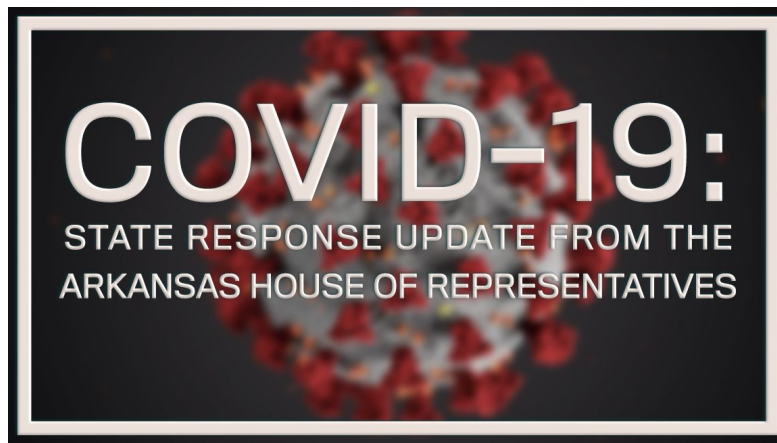

Covid-19 Response Update for July 13, 2020



There were 572 new cases of COVID-19 reported in Arkansas in the last 24 hours. The Department of Health also reported two additional deaths and 19 additional hospitalizations. Of the new hospitalizations, 9 are patients at the Arkansas State Hospital.

The Governor while we currently have enough hospital capacity to adequately meet the needs of Arkansans, we do not want to strain the staff.
