Covid-19 Response Update for August 25, 2020



There were 480 new cases and 15 deaths reported at today's COVID-19 daily update. Hospitalizations have decreased by 24 since yesterday.

The counties with the highest number of new cases are as follows:

Pulaski-80

Faulkner-40

Sebastian-34

Saline-22

Jefferson-19

The Governor said the White House Coronavirus Task Force report has moved Arkansas from a red zone to a yellow zone for test positivity.

The Governor also announced that \$7 million in grants to provide broadband have been awarded to cities and providers. Last week, the Arkansas Legislative Council approved a measure to transfer \$100 million of CARES

Act funding to the Rural Connect Program.
