<u>President Pro Tempore</u> <u>Sen. Jimmy Hickey, Jr.</u>

Senator Jimmy Hickey, Jr., of Texarkana represents District 11 of southwest Arkansas, which includes Lafayette, Little River and Miller Counties and parts of Hempstead and Sevier Counties. First elected in 2012, he took the oath of office on the first day of the 2013 legislative session.

His colleagues elected Senator Hickey as President Pro Tempore of the Senate for the 93rd General Assembly. He is a member of the Senate Committee on Revenue and Taxation, the Senate Insurance and Commerce

Committee, Joint Performance Review Committee and Joint Retirement and Social Security Committee. Sen. Hickey is also a member of the Joint Budget Committee, the Legislative Council and the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee.

Hickey is a member of the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC) and the Southern Legislative Conference (SLC.)

From 2004-2010, Senator Hickey served on the Texarkana, Arkansas School District School Board, where he was named vicepresident and president. He was a banker for 25 years and retired from Commercial National Bank as senior vice president.

A native of Texarkana, Senator Hickey received his Bachelor of Business Administration from East Texas State University. He is married to Denise and they have a son.

Senator Hickey and his wife are members of Trinity Baptist Church.



Speaker of the House Rep. Matthew J. Shepherd

Matthew J. Shepherd is the Speaker of the Arkansas House of Representatives and the Arkansas State Representative for District 6 serving his sixth term in the House. Shepherd lives and practices law in El Dorado at the law firm of Shepherd & Shepherd, P.A. He and his wife, Alie, have three children.

He was born and raised in El Dorado and graduated from El Dorado High School in 1994. Shepherd went on to graduate Magna Cum Laude with a B.A. in History and Political Science from Ouachita Baptist University in 1998 and received his J.D. from the University of Arkansas School of Law in 2001. He is a member of the Union County, Arkansas, Louisiana, and American Bar Associations, and is licensed to practice in the state courts of Arkansas and Louisiana; the United States District Courts for the Western and Eastern Districts of Arkansas, and the Western District of Louisiana; and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit.

Shepherd is the former two-term Chairman of the House Judiciary Committee and is a member of the Joint Budget Committee, the House Judiciary Committee, the House Agriculture, Forestry & Economic Development Committee, and the House Management Committee. Additionally, he serves as Chairman of the Arkansas Code Revision Commission. He was appointed by the Arkansas Supreme Court to it's Special Task Force on Practice and Procedure in Civil Cases and was appointed to the Arkansas Bar Association Task Force on Maintaining a Fair and Impartial Judiciary. Shepherd has received a number of awards and recognitions for his legislative service.

AR General Assembly

The Arkansas General Assembly is made up of two houses, the House of Representatives and the Senate. The House of Representatives has 100 members and the Senate has 35 members. All members of the General Assembly are elected by voters from their respective districts. The primary duties of the General Assembly are to make, amend, and pass laws.

Senate



House of Representatives

35 members

Lieutenant Governor serves as President of the Senate.

In his absence, the Senate President Pro Tempore takes his place. 100 members

The House Speaker is elected by the House members at the beginning of each regular session.

The Arkansas General Assembly meets on the second Monday in January of odd number years for regular session, and on the second Monday in February on even number years for fiscal session. A regular session lasts for 60 days and a fiscal session lasts for up to 30 days, unless the legislature votes to extend either session. The Governor of Arkansas can issue a "call" for a special session during the interims between regular sessions. The Arkansas General Assembly meets at the Arkansas State Capitol in Little Rock.

To be a member of the General Assembly one must. . .

- be at least 25 years old.
- be a resident of Arkansas for at least 2 years.
- be a resident of his/her district for at least 1 year.
- serve a 4 year term.

- be at least 21 years old.
- be a resident of Arkansas for at least 2 years.
- be a resident of his/her district for at least 1 year.
- serve a 2 year term.







The interim period between sessions allows legislators to devote their time to research major issues.

Committees may conduct public hearings and research at a much less hectic pace than while in session, and their recommendations are submitted to the entire General Assemby at the next session. It is during this time that the Legislative Council and Legislative Joint Auditing Committee conduct hearings.

Legislative Council

Performs legislative, fiscal oversight and budgeting.

Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

Audits each department, institution, board, commission, office and agency of state government, as well as counties.

Joint Budget Committee

Reviews budgets for each state agency, institution, and department.

Beginning in October of even-numbered years, the Council joins the Joint Budget Committee for budget hearings.







Arkansas was admitted to the Union


on June 15, 1836.

In 1881, the General Assembly passed a resolution that officially named the state with it's current spelling.


